Review and Award Cycles (Cycle I)

Scientific Merit Review: June – July 2012

Advisory Council Round: August or October 2012*

Earliest Project Start Date: September or December 2012*

* Advisory Council Round for Cycle I applications may be August or October, and their earliest project start date may be September or December respectively.

- SPA requires Investigators to register their intent to submit their grants on the NYUSoM Funding Proposals website (<http://fundingproposals.med.nyu.edu/>). Registering your intent doesn't require you to submit the grant, as the website is mainly used by SPA to manage their staffing needs.
- All Investigators thinking of submitting any type of grant should also send an email to the Division's Grants Manager (Jessica Lorenzo; Jessica.Lorenzo@nyumc.org) notifying her of your intent to submit and the proposed title(s) of the project(s).
- All NIH electronic applications must be submitted via Click GrantsXpress (<http://era.med.nyu.edu/Grants>).
- DGIM/DoM must receive a complete application including final versions of all budgets and budget justifications, including subcontracts, as well as a good draft of the science at least 10 business days prior to the NIH deadline by noon, to the Division Grants Manager. Jessica Lorenzo will review all applications and will obtain the necessary signatures on the Departmental Approval Face Page. Please email her if you anticipate any problems in meeting the above deadlines.
- SPA must receive a complete application including final versions of all budgets including subcontracts as well as a draft version of the science at least 7 business days prior to the NIH deadline.
- SPA must receive the final version of the science itself at least 3 business days prior to the NIH deadline.
